



## Public Hearing Notice Comprehensive Transportation Plan

The city of Naperville will hold a public hearing on Saturday, July 13, 2002 at 8:30 AM in the Council Chambers located at the Naperville Municipal Center, 400 S. Eagle Street, Naperville, Illinois. This public hearing will be held in conjunction with the monthly Transportation Advisory Board meeting, which is being held on July 13, 2002 instead of July 6, 2002 to avoid conflicts with the Fourth of July holiday weekend.

The purpose of this public hearing is to allow the public to comment on the following three (of fourteen) draft components of the Comprehensive Transportation Plan:

- Air Quality and Noise Management Plan
- Arterial Landscaping Plan
- Parking Plan

The comments received will be considered before revised versions of the above plan components are presented to the Transportation Advisory Board at their August 3, 2002 meeting.
